


Update from Nassau County Legislator Carrié Solages:



Follow-up on Meeting Regarding Traffic and Pedestrian Safety Study on Dutch Broadway and Elmont Road



On January 22nd, the Department of Public Works and their contractor, GPI, presented the findings of their Traffic and Pedestrian Safety Study and Draft Plan for Dutch Broadway and Elmont Road at a community meeting I hosted at Elmont Memorial High School. The purpose of the meeting was to not only update the community, but to obtain feedback from local residents on the draft plan. This feedback is necessary to ensure that residents have a voice in making their roads and community safer.

As was mentioned at the meeting, the engineering changes discussed in the Draft Plan are but one part of the necessary piece of making our roadways safer. Along with Engineering, we need Education for our drivers and pedestrians and Enforcement by our local police to ensure that our roadways are safe for all.

While numerous community leaders and residents were in attendance at the meeting, I understand they represent only a small portion of the Elmont community that is affected by these roadways.
