

EXECUTIVE ORDER

Number 4 of 2020

Local Emergency Order No. 2

LAURA CURRAN, County Executive of the County of Nassau, by the powers vested in me by the Nassau County Charter and the Laws of the State of New York do hereby order and declare as follows:

WHEREAS, section 24 of the Executive Law authorizes the chief executive officer of a county, pursuant to a declaration of a local state of emergency, to issue orders to preserve the public safety, well-being and health of the citizens of such county in times of emergency; and

WHEREAS, a local state of emergency was declared and duly executed pursuant to article 2-B of the Executive Law on March 13, 2020, for the whole of the County of Nassau, effective March 13, 2020 at 11:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, due to the rapid increase in the number of COVID-19 cases, we have reached a level where our planning calls for the suspension of classroom and extracurricular activities in schools in the County of Nassau;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

ORDERED, that all classroom and extracurricular functions in all public and private schools situated in the County of Nassau are hereby suspended, except schools may remain open for administrative and staff functions; and be it further

ORDERED, that this Order shall not apply to any program or school approved or operated by the New York State Education Department and/or Office

for People with Developmental Disabilities, to the extent it provides education in a residential setting to school-aged children; and be it further

ORDERED that this emergency order shall take effect at 12:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16, 2020, and shall remain in effect for five (5) days unless sooner rescinded or modified, but may be extended for additional periods not to exceed five (5) days each during the pendency of the local state of emergency.
